Syllabus for Marriage and Family (FMT 505) Front Range Bible Institute Professor Tim Dane (Spring 2014)

I. Course Description

This course is to expose Christians to biblical principles on marriage, family, and parenting. It is a way for each individual to focus on himself/herself and how God's commands apply personally. It will be an opportunity to begin thinking about, and planning for, concrete ways in which each person can proactively serve other family members whom God has given.

II. Course Objectives

- A. Provide men with clear, biblical instructions on how God commands them to be godly husbands.
- B. Provide women with clear, biblical instructions on how God commands them to be godly wives.
- C. Provide men and women with clear, biblical instruction on how God commands them to be godly parents.
- D. Provide men and women with clear, biblical instruction on the standards that God commands and expects with reference to children.
- E. Provide each person with an opportunity to begin taking concrete steps in how they can better serve their family members.

- C. All must read *Shepherding a Child's Heart* over the first four weeks.

- D. All must read Your Family God's Way over the last two weeks.
- E. Master's students must read the additional text by MacArthur on parenting.
- F. All must memorize all Scripture verses on a weekly basis. Each student writes/types out the verses to be memorized without helps and then turns in this verse memorization sheet the next week at the beginning of class.
- G. Marriage objectives and calendar (create your own list of ways you can be a good spouse and make an actual schedule of how you might meet these goals over the future. Think big about your goals and realize that some of these goals will be long-term—but they are goals you can think about and begin planning for.)
- H. Parenting objectives and calendar (create your own list of ways you can be a good parent and make an actual schedule of how you might meet these goals over the future. Think big about your goals and realize that some of these goals will be long-term—but they are goals you can think about and begin planning for.)
