## **Financial Assistance**

One of the primary goals of Front Range is that of keeping student costs as low as feasible (tuition costs are about 20-30% of many seminaries). We recognize that some students may still have difficulty in meeting these reduced costs. Should a student have need of financial assistance, some degree of scholarship assistance may be possible on an "as available" basis. A degree program student who would like such help should obtain a Financial Aid Application from the Executive Director, or Academic Dean.

## **Payment of Accounts**

All tuition, fees, and charges are due and payable at registration.

## **Extended Payment Plan**

Students who are unable to pay their entire semester charges may elect to use our 3-month payment plan. This plan allows students to budget more easily, reducing the size of the tuition payments by spreading them over the qyarter. Actual monthly payments are automatically adjusted when courses are added or dropped, or when enrollment plans change.

For those who choose this plan, a student's quarter tuition charges, based on his enrollment, are paid over a three month period, beginning in September and ending in November for the fall quarter, beginning in January and ending in March for the winter quarter, and beginning in April and ending in June for the Spring Quarter. Winterim and Summerim tuition is paid in full by the last day of class.

No interest is charged in this plan. There is a \$25 per quarter set-up fee and a charge of \$15 for each payment received after the due date. Each payment is due on the tenth of each month. Any balance remaining after the final payment date will be charged interest at the rate of one percent per month. Student tuition accounts must be paid in full by the following deadlines:

- November 10 for the fall quarter
- March 10 for the winter quarter
- June 10 for the spring quarter
