Syllabus for Marriage and Family (FMT 505) Front Range Bible Institute

I. Course Description

This course is to inspire and equip students to faithfully and fruitfully share in God's mission for marriage and family. Students will learn to see the meaning of our created human relationships and how they fit into God's eternal purposes in Christ. Students will have opportunity to develop biblical and practical ways to make their lives a part of this glorious vision.

II. Course Objectives

- B. Provide men with clear, biblical instructions on the glory and goodness of being godly husbands.
- C. Provide women with clear, biblical instructions on the glory and goodness of being godly wives.
- D. Provide men and women with clear, biblical instruction on the glory and goodness of being godly parents.
- E. Provide men and women with clear, biblical instruction on how to bring up children in the discipline and instruction of the Lord.
- F. Provide all students with an opportunity to begin taking concrete steps in how they can better serve their family members.

Think big about your goals and realize that some of these goals will be long-term—but they are goals you can think about and begin planning for.)
